

PROCEDURE FOR LICENSURE BY EXAMINATION FOR A FOREIGN GRADUATE

1. The applicant must contact NABP for review of their credentials.
2. The applicant must complete the entire FPGEC; i.e take and pass the FPGEE, the TSE and the TOFEL. NABP will issue a "Certificate."
3. The applicant submits a copy of the NABP FPGEC to the Kentucky Board of Pharmacy along with the application for Registration as a Pharmacist Intern.
4. After registration as an intern, the applicant will earn 1500 hours of internship and provide proof of internship on the appropriate internship forms.
5. Upon completion of the 1500 hours of internship, the applicant may submit the Pharmacist Licensure Application.
6. The applicant will be issued a Kentucky Pharmacist license upon successful completion of the NAPLEX and the Kentucky MPJE.
